NCPG Transversal Provincial Bursary Programme

Important to note when applying for funding:

- 1) A bursary application does not guarantee a successful outcome.
- 2) Applications submitted after the closing date shall not be considered.
- 3) All applications are subject to an adjudication process led by the Bursary Committee.
- 4) Total number of bursaries are awarded based on the allocated budget reviewed annually.
- 5) Bursary amount per applicant is awarded based on a financial means test/ a sliding scale
- 6) Incomplete applications will automatically be disqualified.
- 7) Bursaries are intended for the scarce and critical skills and hard to fill positions as informed by the sector skills and workplace skills plan of the province. This plan is reviewed annually.
- 8) Post Graduate studies are not funded.
- 9) It is expected of successful applicants to participate in compulsory community service of minimum 80 hours per academic year. (list of NPO's & NGO's are available from Student Affairs)
- 10) Your application must contain the following information:
 - a) Duly completed application as per OTP checklist
 - b) Proof of acceptance and or registration at a registered HEI
 - c) Geographic location (District)
 - d) Fields of study aligned to disciplines identified as scarce and critical within the province
 - e) Gender
 - f) Race
 - g) Age
 - h) Persons with Disabilities are encouraged to apply
 - i) Academic achievement by applicants
 - j) Continuing students – statement of results & participation in compulsory community service programme



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
