## **Fourteen Mobile Classrooms for Hantam High School**

The MEC for Education, Mr Zolile Monakali visited Hantam High School in Calvinia earlier this week to unveil 14 mobile classrooms as a temporary solution to accommodate all learners for normal learning and teaching.

This comes after the closure of the school due to infrastructure related challenges, where a certain section of the school was declared unsafe for usage and further classes. This section of the school building is currently not in use and cordoned off.

The Northern Cape Government believes that a child in school stands a better chance at a brighter successful future and we are pleased that a curriculum recovery plan will be implemented with immediate effect. The Department has pleaded with the school community to safe guard and protect the mobile classrooms.

The department also handed out over 500 dignity packs and sanitary towels to female learners of Gariep High School in Prieska. This initiative forms part of our Sanitary Towel Campaign aimed at keeping girls in school.

### NC Government Visits Prieska Power Reserve Site

A Provincial Government delegation was led by Premier Dr. Zamani Saul on Friday, 26 August 2022, for the first phase of the Prieska Power Reserve stakeholder engagement and site visit.

The Provincial Government delegation included Members of the Executive Council, the Mayor, Councillors of the Siyathemba Municipality, and senior officials from both Local and Provincial Government who joined the Minister of Public Works, Ms. Patricia De Lille, and the Deputy Minister, Ms. Noxolo Kieviet, representatives from the IDC, SIEMENS Energy, CENEC, Thuyssenkrup and the organised Agriculture and Business Forum.

The Prieska Power Reserve Project is a catalytic project that will start producing green hydrogen and ammonia in 2025

natural resources of water and air. Valued at 9.7 billion, the project will during its construction phase create 22 000 jobs directly and indirectly of which 27.5 % and 35% will be allocated to the youth and women respectively, and 636 permanent jobs. SMMEs are also set to benefit from the R2,3 billion which will be sourced locally.

Premier Saul emphasised the importance of people from the province and host communities benefitting from projects like these.
