PRESIDENT CONVENES CABINET LEKGOTLA

President Cyril Ramaphosa convened a Cabinet Lekgotla with leaders from all spheres of government in order to review government's progress on priorities, assess challenges and set the agenda for the seventh administration.

The plan proposes three strategies priorities:

- Inclusive growth.
- Job creation.
- Reducing poverty and tackling the high cost of living

Other areas of focus include funding Small, Medium, and Micro Enterprise (SMMEs) and the "missing middle" in reference to students whose household income is too high to qualify for NSFAS funding, yet too low to afford tertiary education without financial assistance.

The outcome of the meeting will shape government's policies and programmes that will be announced by the President during his State of the Nation Address (**SONA**) in Parliament on Thursday, 6 February 2025 at 19:00.

The year kicks off progressively as the first phase of the Socio-Economic programme took place on the 27-31 January 2025, where traditional leaders from all parts of the Northern Cape came together. The purpose of the gathering is to provide them with the skills and knowledge to drive socio-economic development in their communities. This initiative, supported by the Department of Traditional Affairs (DTA) and the School of Government (NSG), will focus on:

- Empowering traditional leaders to become change agents.
- Re-orienting traditional leadership to prioritize sustainable economic growth.
- Promoting the sustainable use of local resources.

The second phase will commence in March 2025, ultimately leading to the certification of Traditional leaders as competent in fostering community development.

This week, SASSA Northern Cape embarked on a three-day media campaign community radio stations to educate and engage beneficiaries on the Grant-In-Aid and Social Grant Payment Dates for February 2025. The campaign aired on Kurara FM, Radio Kaboensa, Radio NFM, Radio Riverside, Ulwazi FM, Revival FM, Vaaltar FM, and Radio Teemaneng.

Grant-In-Aid is a monthly grant provided to beneficiaries who are already receiving the Old Age Grant, War Veterans Grant, or Disability Grant (Temporary or Permanent) and require regular care due to a physical or mental condition. Qualification is subject to a medical assessment.

February 2025 Social Grant Payment Dates:

- Older Persons Grant & Linked Grants: 4 February 2025.

- Disability Grants & Linked Grants: 5 February 2025.
- All Other Grants: 6 February 2025.
- COVID-19 SRD Grants: 24–28 February 2025 (for approved applicants).
